

Interim List (pending full catalogue & numbering) of Papers and Missionary Collections of Revd. Ron (Ronald Arthur Hubert) Bocking (Acc.2015/02)

Revd. Ronald Bocking (1923-2012) read classics at King's College Cambridge and, after interruption for wartime service, studied theology at New College, London, where he later occasionally lectured in historical theology and was a tutor 1954-63. As a minister in the Congregational and United Reformed Churches 1949-88 (spent mainly in the London and Bristol suburbs) he appears never to have served abroad but nevertheless had a lifetime interest in missionary work, perhaps encouraged during war service in the King's Africa Rifles in Nyasaland [now Malawi] and Kenya. He was secretary for the joint committee of Congregational and Presbyterian churches on overseas mission, in preparation for the creation of the United Reformed Church in 1972, and thereafter on the URC's Council for World Mission, making several overseas for Council and consultative meetings, with a particular interest in southern Africa and the Far East. These are mainly his papers as a member of this Council. An obituary was published in the *URC Year Book 2013* (a publication he helped design; copy available).

Received in three boxes, two for Singapore and Malaysia 1975, the third for Taiwan and Sweden. These comprised on deposit a large number of essentially tourist snaps of characteristic features of the locations, and similar subjects produced commercially, of which only a few have been selected for preservation, to show named individuals or locations such as churches, colleges and hospitals etc related to purpose of the visit. More outside that narrow definition were kept for outside Taipai, Taiwan as it seemed slightly less likely images would be as easily available.

Boxes 1 and 2 had index lists on card which have been retained. Box 3 had no more than some notes on the trip for doing a 'slide show' on the Taiwan visit. A list of all retained slides was created, now numbered 1-91 and including a column for the old numbers of those in boxes 1-2, from which the list. The slides are labelled on the slides themselves, but names are often difficult to read. The index lists sometimes provide additional or slightly variant information. In summary they comprise:
