## **Summary of Archive Accessions 2015-2024**

This is a summary of all accessions since 2015. Only a few have been catalogued in full and the catalogue available on the Centre's <u>website</u> but with a few exceptions (mainly for data protection reasons) all are available on application to the archivist.

It is extracted from the Archives Accessions Register with some editorial intervention, e.g. transfers from members of Centre staff have been reduced to 'Henry Martyn Trust', and is shown in accessions order, usually chronological, so that some collections received in instalments may appear more than once, sometimes several times. Archive collections may vary from a single item to many boxes of records. Smaller collections are inevitably described in relatively greater detail. Several collections marked below with an asterisk remain only partly processed and for these the descriptions are necessarily general.

Summaries of archive accessions have since 2013 been submitted to The National Archives (TNA) annual survey of additions to collections and selected 'highlights' from these returns up to 2022 only have been added by TNA to various its online accession lists in succession to the former Historical Manuscripts Commission's National Register of Archives publication Accessions to Repositories. This practice has now been discontinued and instead the full returns from 2016 are being made available at data.gov.uk. These very large national spreadsheets may be difficult for the unfamiliar to navigate (particularly 20116-17 which are merely .txt files and it is essential to know the CCCW ARCHON number 1835). Printed copies of these submissions are in the box of archives catalogues above the reading room staff desk. Collection descriptions to TNA requirements are however much briefer than those below.

Some revision of descriptions, usually minor, may have taken place since this document was originally created in May 2024.
